	<p>The former areas of the Lower Germanic Limes will be included in the World Heritage List until 2020 as an extension of the development of the transnational UNESCO World Heritage Site Borderlines of the Roman Frontiers.</p> <p>The project forms part of the extension of the transnational UNESCO World Heritage site Borderlines of the Roman Frontiers in the elaboration of a Master Plan for the area of the former Roman military camp Castra Bonnensis in Bonn-Castel. The master plan includes the creation of a conservation and placement concept in cooperation with „LVR Department at Preservation and Care of Field Monuments in the Rheinland“, the LVR-Landes Museum in Bonn as well as the urban planning development of the City of Bonn.</p> <p>The project can accordingly serve as a prototype for the elaboration of conservation and placement concept for other nomination proposals for the Lower German Limes. Thus, it is also a basis for the future Management Plan of the potential serial World Heritage site, which will be elaborated together with the Dutch project partners.</p>
