	<p>The City of Istanbul, in 2010, planned the construction of a new metro bridge on the Golden Horn, which separates the two European parts of the city from each other. Since the Suleymaniya Mosque as an integral part of the UNESCO World Heritage Site <i>Historic Areas of Istanbul</i>, is located in the immediate vicinity of the proposed bridge, the impact of the proposed plan on the Outstanding Universal Value of the World Heritage Site was to be assessed.</p> <p>Due to the complicated political backgrounds of this project, the Heritage Impact Assessment was accompanied by an international expert advisory board and linked to a workshop process which aimed to develop strategies to modify the planned bridge.</p>
