	<p>The Austrian province of Lower Austria plans to build a new museum, the so-called Landesgalerie Niederösterreich in the UNESCO World Heritage site Wachau Cultural Landscape. The impact of the new building on the Outstanding Universal Value of the World Heritage property, therefore, had to be evaluated through a Heritage Impact Assessment. Recommendations for further operation corridors had to be developed on the basis of the assessment.</p> <p>The project included a summary of the historical development of the affected area between the two towns of Krems and Stein, key aspects of the proposed building, as well as previous World Heritage Compatibility studies for the project. Afterwards, the assessment of the World Heritage Compatibility was carried out on the basis of the computer-assisted visualizations.</p>
